Once again the Terrebonne High School Band Boosters will be holding their Battle on the Bayou marching contest on Saturday, October 19, 2024. It would be our pleasure for you to consider participating in our marching contest/festival.

The Battle on the Bayou will use caption judging and will have a full CSJA panel. Central States Judging Association will provide the judges for this show. Scores will be given in the captions of Music Ensemble, GE Coordination, Visual Ensemble, Percussion and Auxiliary.

Once again, we will offer a contest class and a separate festival class. If a director is not familiar with caption judging or believes that one's band is not yet ready to compete; you do not have to compete. You can participate in a festival class and get comments and ratings only. Festival class bands will perform first in their particular class, so students and directors will be able to perform around the same time as other bands of the same size.

The Battle on the Bayou will be a great experience for all participating bands. Large and small bands will receive quality comments from nationally renowned judges. There will also be a critique after awards for all participating bands, regardless if you are in the competition class or festival class. Comments will be available after your band performs through drop box. The success of caption judging was evident in last year's Showcase of Marching Bands, where many top 10 bands participated in caption judged events. The goal of our contest is for students and directors to leave with a quality and educational experience.

This contest/festival will be in the afternoon. Our contest is on a compact campus with our school building blocking all sounds from warm up to the field so they cannot be heard from the performance area. This makes for quick and easy transitions from unloading to warm up and performance. Terrebonne High School has proven that it is a great campus to host this competition!
